WHAT ARE IGCSE AND GCSE?

International General Certificate of Secondary Education an English language-based examination recognized in the United Kingdom as being equivalent to the GCSE for the purposes of recognizing prior attainment. It was developed by the University of Cambridge International Examinations. Students typically will take their IGCSE exams after 2 years of study or age 14(+) years. General Certificate of Secondary Education marks the completion of Secondary Education in the UK. British students typically will take their GCSE exams at the end of Year 11 when they are 16 years old.

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF STUDYING IGCSE?

Students outside of the UK who are interested in UK education qualifications are free to take IGCSE exams without any prior educational certificate. This makes IGCSE the best option for students who do not possess the **Kenya Certificate of Primary Education** qualifications but wish to proceed to High School, A-level, IB, pre-university and finally to the University to further their studies. IGCSE are internationally recognized qualifications. Candidates can sit IGCSE examinations all over the world. IGCSEs are widely accepted by universities and colleges as part of their entry requirements.

EXAMINATION BOARDS

IGCSEs are offered by Pearson Edexcel and Cambridge exam boards in the UK.

HOW TO CHOOSE IGCSE SUBJECTS

Generally, students will take a minimum of 5, up to a maximum of 9-12 subjects at IGCSE. In IGCSE subjects including:

NOTE:

It's important to remember that top-ranking universities will consider the quality of the IGCSE that you have taken rather than the quantity. Taking a smaller number of IGCSE subjects will not inhibit your chances of a successful application, as long as you achieve strong grades in the subjects that you take.
