The ATD examination consists of three levels, the (Level I, II and III). A student must pass the level before proceeding, to the next level and cannot sit for the levels simultaneously.

For June Examinations:-

Register by 15th March of the Current year.

For December Examination:-

Register by 15th September of the Current year.

Minimum of any of the following:-

- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) aggregate of at least grade of C+.
- Such other certificates or Diplomas as may be approved by the board.

Exemptions

Exemptions may, on application to KASNEB be granted to registered students who are holders of certain degrees, certificates and diplomas recognised by KASNEB.
